



Franz Ruzicka is a well known Munich based artist who has been showing his sensual paintings in Munich since 1986. Some of his works are marketed by a well known art publishing house, where one poster reached the top 20 bestseller ranking worldwide. His works have aroused interest in, and sold to national and international art collectors, sports personalities, and well known actors.

He recently celebrated 25 years as an artist with a solo show in the Orangerie of the English Garden, Munich. (May 2011). This year he was also selected for and participated in the "Ausstellung St. Leopold Friedenspreis" at Stift Klosterneuburg. The topic of this humanitarian based arts award in 2011 was "justice brings peace".



Ruzicka displays the nature and beauty of man through his paintings. Dissolving objectivity, his work shows a constant cycle between figurative and abstract. His art is an antidote to a world ruled by rationality, and is timeless. While having great depth of meaning, the paintings are bright and inspiring, and never heavy to the viewer. In form and spirit they conjure feelings of release, and images of flight, as if in a beautiful dream.
